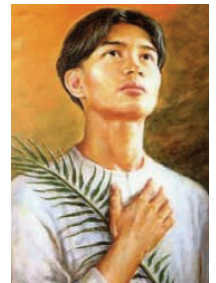

APRIL 2nd St. Pedro Calungsod, the second Filipino to be canonized as a saint. Pedro Calungsod (1654-1672) was born in the Visayan Islands in the Philippines. He joined Fr. Diego de San Vitores in a missionary trip to Guam to assist the Jesuit missionaries when he was just a teenager. With a spirit of faith and trust in God, the young Pedro left his country to help bring the good news to the natives of Guam as a catechist. At the age of 17, Pedro was martyred alongside Fr. Diego by a hostile native. He was canonized on October
