

Liturgical Considerations Upon the Election of the New Pope

Upon the election of the new Pope, both the diocesan Bishop and Priests in every parish should offer a special Mass for the newly-elected Pope in accord with the liturgical calendar.

Yellow and white bunting may be hung on the exterior doors of all parish churches.

The "Mass for the Pope" [especially on the anniversary of election] is appropriate. This Mass cannot be used on the Sundays of Advent, Lent and Easter, solemnities, Ash Wednesday, and the weekdays of Holy Week.

The Mass text is found in the section, "Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions, no. 2" in The Roman Missal.


Some of the following petitions might be used.



St. Matthias Apostle & Martyr (c. 80) Feast Day - 14 May

According to Acts 1:15-26, during the days after the Ascension Peter stood



up in the midst of the brothers—about 120 of Jesus' followers. Now that Judas had betrayed his ministry, it was necessary, Peter said, to fulfill the scriptural recommendation that another should take his office. "Therefore, it is necessary that one of the men who accompanied us the whole time the Lord Jesus came and went among us, beginning from the baptism of John until the day on which he was taken up from us, become with us a witness to his resurrection" (Acts 1:21-22). They nominated two men: Joseph Barsabbas and Matthias. They prayed and drew lots. The choice fell upon Matthias, who was added to the Eleven.

Matthias is not mentioned by name anywhere else in the New Testament.
